

Football Interview: CLAY CALI) WELL


Even though it has been a rough season so far for the Bulldog Football team, senior Clay Caldwell still has his head held high and

Apple iPhone 11






The 73rd Annual Apple Festival



North Carolina is the 7th largest apple-producing state in the nation, and Henderson County is the largest


