The drink can be made at home with few simple steps that leave you free to enjoy this fall drink year round.

- 2 tbsp of pure pumpkin puree
- 1 cup milk (you can use whole,coconut,almond,and skim milk)
- 1 tbsp sugar
- 1/4 tbsp pure vanilla extract
- 1/4 cup of strong coffee
- 1/4 tbsp pumpkin pie spices

Start by combining the pumpkin puree, vanilla extract, pumpkin pie spice, and milk on the stove while you brew your coffee. Once you have heated all your ingredients combine the coffee and your mixture. To add extra flavor you can use whip cream and cinnamon on top! Once you have completed all these

steps, the only thing left to do is enjoy!


