- 3. BMW Scholarship!!!!! Are there any senior students interested in the BMW Scholarship Program at Spartanburg Community College, the application to apply is now open. You can find more information by visiting the Guidance Page located on the Boiling Springs High School website.
- **4. Swofford Open House:** We will be Hosting an Open House on Thursday, March 10th, from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. (drop-in format). While our current Swofford students/families are invited, we are also inviting all students in grades 7 thru 10, who would like to come to meet instructors and investigate some of our programs.
- 5. The **BMW Scholars Program** is a two-year program in which students will attend class full-time at one of our four partner colleges (Spartanburg Community College, Greenville Technical College, Tri-County Technical College, and Piedmont Technical College), while working part-time at BMW Manufacturing Co., LLC. Students will spend their time working and training in one of three designated program tracks: automotive, logistics, or technical. At the end of the program, students will become potential candidates for full-time positions. However, there is no obligation for continued employment following graduation. The starting wage is \$14.50 per hour, and tuition assistance is provided each semester while in the program.

To apply, students must enroll in one of the four partner colleges and must pursue a program related to one of our program tracks, such as mechatronics, automotive, business management, or supply chain management. A minimum 2.8 GPA is required, and students must commit to working up to 20 hours per week at BMW during the course of the program.
