School Community Achievements

Academic

- Our Graduation was 90.4% for the class of 2017 which is above the state of South Carolina's average and the BEST in our school's history.
- Boiling Springs High School was again recognized as an Elite School as 92.45 of all students who challenged the 2017 Advanced Placement tests passed with a score of three or better.
- The Boiling Spring High School Senior Class of 2017 posted an average SAT Score of 1084 and an average ACT Score of 19. Both categories are higher than the South Carolina state average composite score and show improvement from our last reporting year.
- 82.02% percent of all students who graduated from Boiling Springs High School's Class of 2017 continued their education at a post-secondary institution.

Fine Arts

- The Boiling Springs High School Bulldog Marching Band achieved a 4th place finish during the 2017-2018 South Carolina State 5A Marching Band Championship. Additionally, they placed 1st in the state of South Carolina in the 2018 Winter Winds Competition, 2nd in the state of South Carolina in the 2018 Winter Percussion Competition and 6th in the state in the 2018 Winter Color-Guards Competition.
- Mrs. Kimberly Jones produced her 53th Drama Production "**One Mad Night**" during the 2017-2018 school year.
- The Boiling Springs High School Band and Orchestra posted Excellent Ratings at their 2017-2018 Rating Festivals.

Athletics

- The 2017-2018 Boys Varsity Football team had three outstanding Senior Athletes to participate in post season All-Star Games. Alexander Deel participated in the 2017 North-South Shrine Bowl. Graham Derrick and Dylan Brook participated in the 2017 South Carolina North/South All-Star football game.
- The Boiling Springs High School Fishing Team finished in 2nd place in the South Carolina High School Fishing Tournament for the 2017-2018 school year.
- The Male Swim Team was the 2017-2018 Region-2 5A Champions and Zachery Bambach was the Region-2 5A Male Swimmer of the Year.
- Our 2017 Cheerleading Team finished 4th in the State of South Carolina among all 5A Cheerleading Teams.
- Our 2017-2018 Wrestling team had three wrestlers to finish in a top 4 place or above in the South Carolina Wrestling Championship. Drew Thomas was All State, the Region Wrestler of the Year, County Wrestler of the Year and North/South All Star Game Champion. Tyrel Davis and Saben Heenehan were All State.
