## 2024 Graduation Guidelines

We are proud to celebrate the Boiling Springs High School Class of 2024. Our graduation ceremony will take place at 9:00am on Saturday, May 18, 2024 at Boiling Springs High School Bulldog Stadium. Gates will open at 7:00am. Our graduates will begin their procession to the stadium at 8:40am, please plan to be seated by this time. It is our intention to proceed with the ceremony as scheduled unless there is severe weather. If severe weather occurs, alternate plans will be announced via social media and the school website. In the event of light rain, we will proceed with the ceremony as scheduled. Please bring ponchos and rain jackets. Umbrellas are not allowed in the stadium in an effort to preserve the sightline of all guests.

### Important Guidelines:

- Graduation practice is Friday, May 17 at 8:00am. Practice is **MANDATORY** for all graduates in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- During graduation practice, each graduate will receive a parking pass to use on the day of graduation and ten (10) tickets for the graduation ceremony. Every guest, regardless of age, must have a ticket.
- The event will be available to view by livestream. To access our livestream of graduation, the public can find the YouTube link on our website as well as all Social Media accounts from Boiling Springs High School.
- Guests will not be allowed on the field before or during the ceremony.
- Graduates are asked to report to the Legacy Gym immediately after the ceremony to pick up diploma packets.

## General Guidelines for the Class of 2024

1. The ceremony begins with seniors marching in and concludes with the principal formally recognizing the class with the tossing of mortarboards. Members of the audience and the graduating seniors must refrain from shouting, calling names, applauding loudly, using noisemakers such as air horns and bells, etc. during the ceremony.
2. It is especially important to maintain dignity during the portion of the ceremony when each graduate's name is called and he/she is recognized before the entire audience. In the past, noise made in celebration for one student has made it difficult for the family and friends of the next student to hear the name of their honoree as it was announced.
3. Extra security will be present at the ceremony to assist school officials in implementing this policy. Individuals who fail to comply with these requests will be asked to leave the graduation ceremony.
5. Several years ago the Board of Trustees revised Policy JICDA "Code of Conduct" to include that any senior prank that would result in suspension from school will automatically forfeit the student's right to participate in graduation exercises with his/her class.
