School Community Achievements

We successfully incorporated the Boiling Springs High Freshman Academy into Bulldog Nation.

Academic

- Our Graduation Rate was **89.8%** for the class of 2020, which is above the state of South Carolina's average.
- The Class of 2020 had 33 Palmetto Fellows recipients, and 83.4% of our graduating seniors were eligible for the Life Scholarship.
- Over 67% of all students who graduated from Boiling Springs High School's Class of 2019 continued their education at a post-secondary institution.

Fine Arts

- The Boiling Springs High School Bulldog Band had 30 students chosen for Region Band and 3 in All-State.
- The pandemic changed our capacity at performances, however, our Drama students recreated scenes from their favorite musicals and recorded them for us to enjoy.
- The Chorus placed 16 students in the South Carolina Region Choir program. One of our students was selected to participate in the Prestigious South Carolina All-State Choir.
- The Orchestra program had 6 students participate in the SCMEA Orchestra Division One Region Orchestra. These students are auditioning for All-State.
