- -U. S. History 1 Unit
- -Government/ Economics 1 Unit
- -Additional Social Studies 1 Unit
- -Physical Education 1 Unit

### College Entrance Test

-4 year colleges and universities accept both ACT and SAT

-ACT – Tests knowledge level in such areas as English, Math, Science and Social Studies

-SAT – Tests higher level critical thinking skills

-2 year technical or community colleges require their own entrance exam if student has not an ACT or SAT score.
