## College Entrance Test

-4 year colleges and universities accept both ACT and SAT
-ACT - Tests knowledge level in such areas as English, Math, Science and Social Studies
-SAT - Tests higher level critical thinking skills
-2 year technical or community colleges require their own entrance exam if student has not an ACT or SAT score.
