We are announcing another great summer of Driver Education at Boiling Springs High School. We are held to state requirements and we abide by them in all that we do. We will hold in person class for two (2) days and will only remain in class for two hours each day. The remainder of the classroom portion will be completed online through Google Classroom. All completed materials will be turned in on the final face to face class day. This will fulfill the state requirement of classroom instruction.

On Monday June 5th, we will meet in the driver's education room (F 124) which is located above the main gym at Boiling Springs High School. Students will need to be dropped off at the gym lobby entrance located in between the main and freshman campuses. Students will need to have their permit with them for this meeting, as well as, a June calendar with any vacation or days that they may not be able to drive with the instructors. During this meeting we will schedule every drive for the month of June so it is imperative that the students be prepared with their calendar. No time should be missed. If there is, however, it will be made up with an instructor at a rate of \$30.00 per hour/ per student.

On the first day please bring:

- Folder type notebook that has a binder for paper
- Blue/black ink pen or a pencil
- Any personal needs such as corrective lens, medicine, etc.
- Your vacation schedule (We can work around vacations times/dates.)

Important things to remember:

- Be on time; you may not miss any classes
- It is necessary that you acquire your permit by Monday, June 3, 2024.
- Your student must be at least 15 years old by Monday, June 3, 2024.
- You will need to have your permit with you in class Monday, June 3, 2024.
- Your student must pass the classroom portion of the class in order to obtain their PDLA form which is required to take the SC driver's license test.
- Your student must complete and pass the Alive @ 25 course in order to receive credit for Driver Education at Boiling Springs High School. Alive @ 25 is a course developed by the National Safety Council. It is designed to prevent the #1 killer of teens; automobile crashes. Available testing dates will be given to students during Summer Driver Education and will also be online. The cost of this course is included in the summer Driver Education fee.

Driving:

- Driving will be in pairs with each pair driving a total of 6 hours. The driving times will be determined based off both the students and instructors availability. This meets state requirements for behind the wheel experience.
- Driving will be on rural roads, downtown areas, interstate drives and a maneuvers drive. These cover the requirements for the DMV driving test.

Cost:

The cost is \$305 for students of Spartanburg District 2. The cost includes the \$40 for the Alive @ 25 course. A maximum of thirty (30) students will be enrolled. **In order to register**, you must bring this completed form along with your *full payment to the Business Office of the BSHS main campus*. Note: This class fee will be non-refundable after Friday, May 17, 2024. You may call the Business Office at 864-594-9404 if you have questions.
