What: Our 4-week Summer Bridge Program supports high school graduates in preparing for the academic rigor of college courses – especially math. We want to refresh your skills and help you build a solid foundation for achievement. If you are nervous about your math skills or passing college classes, this program is designed for you. We have expert instructors and staff ready to help you achieve your college goals, and we are now accepting applications for Summer 2024.

Qualifying high school graduates will receive scholarships to cover their summer tuition, fees, and books. Students will attend class and relevant programming each day on our Spartanburg campus.
